

Disciplinary procedures:

Junior members

If at any time during a session a member does not comply with the codes of conduct a representative of the club will:

- 1. On the first occasion give a verbal warning,
- 2. On the second occasion, in the presence of another representative, issue a final verbal warning,
- 3. On the third occasion, in the presence of another representative, the member will be asked to sit out the rest of the session. The club will then speak to the member's parents/guardian.

If at a subsequent session there is a re-occurrence, the club will write to the member's parents/guardian, formally informing them of the member's behaviour and state that further breaches of the Code of Conduct will result in expulsion from the club.

Senior members

If at any time during a session a member does not comply with the codes of conduct a representative of the club will;

- 1. On the first occasion give a verbal warning,
- 2. On the second occasion, in the presence of another representative, issue a final verbal warning,
- 3. On the third occasion, in the presence of another representative, the member will be asked to sit out the rest of the session.

If at a subsequent session there is a re-occurrence, the club will write to the member, warning that any further breaches of the Code of Conduct will result in expulsion from the club.
